Unlike a regular traditional Irish music session, we will play the tunes slowly with several repetitions so that it will be possible to learn the tunes easily. You will also learn the etiquette of sessions so that when you are ready to join a real session you will not be out of place.

There is no prerequisite to attend, we just ask that you are comfortable with your instrument and can play basic scales.
